OUR MISSION....

People of different background pour into Mumbai everyday for various reasons. Many poor people who migrate to this great city for work often find themselves living in streets and railway stations. As the parents go to work for daily wages, Children find themselves free to beg or just play aimlessly without education or guidance. Some of the Children in the streets are runaways also. These children adapt to the street life eventually and refrain from living a normal child's life. The street life robs their innocence and childhood. This eventually ruins their lives. Boys and girls (above 12 yrs) who express their desire to come out of the life of begging to get education and to turn their aimless existence to purposeful life in this world are taken under our care for 4yrs. The children live in our residential care (step-up school) and get education with special coaching.

Many children work in the streets, hotels, factories, in houses as maidservant because their earnings are needed by their families.It is difficult rehabilitate these children as their income is the means of survival of their families and them. In order to cater to the needs of such children (above 14) COGF has **step-in centers** where such children are taught accn to their convenience.

STEP-IN CENTER

On march 24th team COGF started their 2nd step-in center at bhandup. From past five years we have been working in this area conducting workshops and advocacy programmes and it was time that we started a study center in this place as most of them were not attending regular schooling. Some of the children manage to somehow finish their primary education they are forced to quit schooling in order to support their family or themselves. Team COGF aims at focusing on the following areas

Objectives

- Preventive program (work to prevent the children from
- taking to the streets through family and community support and education)
- Onetime nutritious meal
- Basic medical assistance
- Education
- Family reunification
- Helping marginalized youth gain entrepreneurship and employability skills.

Present status

After door to door convincing the parents to send their children to study, 10 children are attending the center and are benefitted.

My name is Sandeep tiwari & I am working with COGF as caretaker. As a child I used to live with my family in Dahishar, my father who was working as a watchman used to drink and beat us up regularly One day while he was drunk he beat us and kicked us out of our home. We were forced to live in kurla platform, to survive on the streets I used to work on daily wages of 50 to 60 Rs in shops. Later as I made friends on streets I used to rag pick and with money coming in easily I started drinking and using drugs. one morning staff from (Ashadeep center)OASIS -INDIA came and invited us to come to their center. Initially reluctant, after few days I used to frequently visit their center. After somedays I was sent to wadala center and as I was missing my mother I ran away from there.

Next I was sent to COGF, I was 12 then and again ran away as I was addicted to drugs After really hard times on the street decided to return back., from then on the journey of my life took an positive turn. I started to read and write and after 7 attempts in three years cleared my 10th These three years were really hard and made me take the important decision in life, to spend the rest of my life for the children who are in need.

At present I have taken admission for bachelors in social work and also working for COGF. I am thankful and grateful to the people who helped me to shape my life, and my God who was always guiding me wonderfully!!!!!
